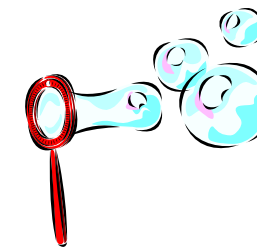

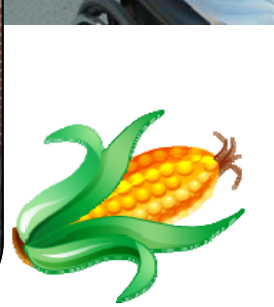
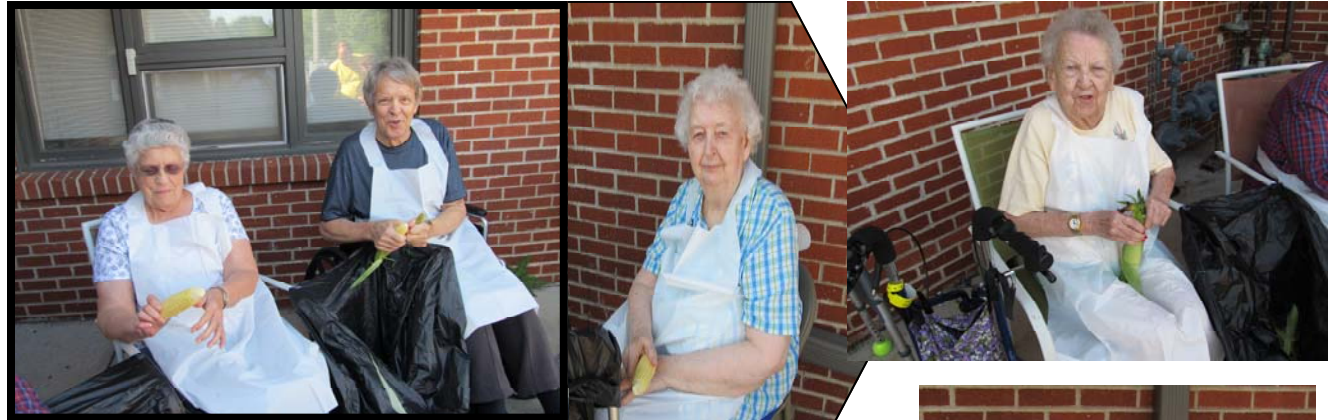


Our residents receive a red

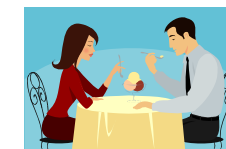
